Bradley Bourbonnais Community High School

FACILITY

Eight lanes, 25 yard pool with non-turbulent lane lines, The minimum water depth, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 13 feet, 0 inches at the start end and 4 feet, 2 inches at the turn end. Warm-up/cool-down pool is located at opposite end (beyond bulkhead), Kiefer permanent starting blocks, Daktronics OmniSport 2000 Timing System with automatic touch pads, and Hy-Tek Meet Manager 5.0 will be used. Seating capacity for spectators is 200. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

RULES AND SAFETY

- *The use of audio or visual capable recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest room, locker rooms or on deck in the area behind the starting blocks.*
- *Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms is prohibited.*
- *Only swimmers, coaches and officials are allowed in locker rooms / changing areas, and other than an emergency, coaches and officials should inform the meet director when doing so.*
- *The operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.*
- **All other current USA Swimming and ISI Rules and Regulations apply, and will be strictly enforced.**

ELIGIBILITY

All USA Swimming registered swimmers are eligible. All swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadlines. Entries listed as "Registration applied for" will not be accepted. Registration forms can be obtained from the Illinois Swimming Office, 1400 E. Touhy Ave. Suite 410, Des Plaines, IL 60018, Phone 847-824-1596 Fax 847-824-1726. A swimmer's age as of January 28, 2018 will determine their age for the meet.

USA SWIMMING, INC MEMBERSHIP

Insurance regulations require that all swimmers, coaches, officials or any others on deck be current members of USA Swimming. It is each club's responsibility to register their swimmers, coaches, and officials. Other than BBSC volunteers, **any swimmers, coaches, officials or any others who are not current members of USA Swimming can not participate in the meet or be on deck.**

COACHES

All coaches must be currently registered with USA Swimming and must continuously display their current USA Coach member registration card at all times while on deck.

SWIMMER DIVE CERTIFICATION

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ENTRY DEADLINE

The Entry Chairperson will not accept entries before January 8, 2018 at 8:00 AM. E-mail entries are strongly encouraged and should be sent to BBSCmeets@yahoo.com. Mailed entries, in the case of ex. unattached swimmers, may be sent to the Entry Chairperson (listed above). Please be sure to sign the signature waiver if using overnight mail. No hand delivered entries will be accepted. Entries must be received by January 20, 2018.

ENTRIES

All entries will comply with current USA Swimming and ISI Rules and Regulations. Current registration number, age, first name, middle initial, and last name must appear on all entries. Hy-Tek Meet Manager 5.0 will be used. Team entries should be submitted by e-mail. Entries may be submitted in hardcopy by mail if less than 10 swimmers. Entries must be submitted for short-course yards (SCY).

A signed Summary Fee/ Release Form provided in this packet and payment in full must be received prior to the start of the meet. Checks are to be made payable to **Bradley Bourbonnais Swim Club**. Meet host will accept no responsibility for transmission errors of faxed or emailed entries. It will remain up to the sender to verify receipt of entries.

ENTRY FEES

\$2.00 per swimmer; \$4.00 per event.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

Deck entries may be permitted, but due to the nature of this event, deck entries or any event changes after publication will disqualify a swimmer from eligibility for the hi-point trophy. Swimmers may enter up to any 4 events in their age group (Can be multiple events of the same stroke if desired)

ENTRY VERIFICATION

Entries will be acknowledged by reply e-mail or phone.

ACCOMMODATIONS FOR SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES

In accordance with USA Swimming Rules; Articles 105 and 202.1.13, the Meet Referee has the authority to accommodate swimmers with disabilities. It is the responsibility of the coaches or swimmers to contact the Meet Referee, prior to competition, with specific requests.

BULLPEN

A Bullpen will be run to clerk the swimmers.

SEEDING

All events will be timed finals from slowest to fastest. Short course yard times should be submitted for entry purposes. There is NO positive check-in.

SCORING

The scoring for the Sprint will be done by adding the points scored for the swimmers four events. DQ, NS or not swimming 4 events will disqualify the swimmer from competing for the Hi-Point. In the event of a tie, total yardage swum will determine Hi-Point placement for each age group. There will be no team scoring.

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to the top three high-point place winners in each age group. Ribbons will be awarded to the first 16 places for each event. The 11 – 12, 13 - 14 and 15 – 18 age groups will be swum together, but scored separately. No team awards will be given.

ADMISSION & PSYCH SHEETS

Admission will be \$5.00 per person for all spectators 11 years old or over. The heat sheet will be emailed to each team for forwarding to their swimmers. Copies will be available at the pool.

CONCESSIONS

Concessions will be available in the gym adjacent to the pool.

NO SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted anywhere on school property in accordance with state law. This includes the school's parking lot and grounds.

MEET RESULTS

A Hy-tek results file will be sent to each team after the meet. A pdf of the Official Meet Results will be posted on the team web site at www.bbscdolphins.com as soon as available.

TIMERS AND OFFICIALS

All teams with a minimum of 10 swimmers in a session are asked to submit the name of a team contact for timers. Such teams may be responsible for providing at least two timers for a lane for the entire session should the need arise.

CONTROLLED MEET WARM-UP and SAFETY GUIDELINES

A. WARM-UP PROCEDURES

1. General Warm-up guidelines
 - a. During swimming warm-ups, swimmers must enter the pool feet first from the start, maintaining contact with the pool by hand when entering
 - b. Entry into the pool is allowed from the starting end of pool only, unless approved otherwise by the meet director and meet referee.
 - c. **NO DIVING OR STARTS** are allowed while circle swimming is taking place. Each coach will determine when they choose to begin starts but not before ensuring that all circle swimming has ceased in their lane.
 - d. Swimmers doing backstroke starts must be certain that no other swimmer is on the block.
2. POOL LANE USE:
 - a. Lane assignments will be posted at both ends of the pool and in the swimmer holding area.
 - b. Coaches shall be responsible for supervision in lanes with their swimmers and following warm-up and safety guidelines.

B. SAFETY GUIDELINES

1. Coaches Responsibilities
 - a. Coaches shall instruct their swimmers regarding safety guidelines and warm-up procedures as they apply to conduct at meets and practices.
 - b. Coaches shall actively supervise their swimmers throughout the warm-up session at meets and all practices.
2. Host Team Responsibilities
 - a. Marshaling
 - i. A minimum of two (2) marshals, who report to and receive instructions from the Meet Referee, shall be on the deck during the warm-up session.
 - ii. Marshals shall have the authority to remove from the deck, for the remainder of the warm-up session, any swimmer or coach who is in violation of safety or warm-up procedures.
 - b. The host team shall provide signs for each lane at both ends of the pool, which indicate the designated use during warm-up.
 - c. Warm-up times and lane assignments shall be published in the meet information and posted at several locations around the pool area. The following statement shall appear in the information: "Illinois Swimming, Inc. Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in affect at this meet."
 - d. An announcer shall be on duty for the entire Warm-Up session to announce any lane and/or time changes and to assist with the conduct of the Warm-up.
 - e. Hazards in locker rooms, on the deck area or in areas used by coaches, swimmers, spectators, or officials shall be removed or clearly marked.
3. Miscellaneous:
 - a. Backstrokers shall ensure that they are not starting at the same time as a swimmer on the blocks.
 - b. Swimmers shall not jump or dive into the pool to stop another swimmer on a recalled start.
 - c. Swimmers are required to exit the pool upon completion of their warm-up to allow other swimmers adequate warm-up time. The pool is not for visiting or playing during the warm-up session.
 - d. Warm-up procedures shall be enforced for any breaks scheduled during the competition.
 - e. The Referee may restrict use of bands, hand paddles, or fins during warm-up. The Referee shall have control over mitigation actions necessary to relieve situations deemed as dangerous or impairing the safety of other swimmers.

NOTE: Host clubs may, with the consent of the Meet Director and Meet Referee, modify the warm-up time schedule or recommended lane assignments depending on pool configuration, number of swimmers or other consideration, so long as safety considerations are not compromised. Any such changes shall be announced, and/or posted prominently in the pool area.
